Adjustment factors are also awarded for recognised GUESTS equivalents completed at other Tertiary institutions (e.g. QUT-START, UQ – Enhanced Studies Program).

Some programs are excluded from the pathway, including the Bachelor of Medical Science (MD Provisional Entry for School Leavers) and the Bachelor of Dental Health Science.
