1. INTRODUCTION

Parking privileges may be granted to Professors with honorific titles in recognition of the valuable assistance which they provide to the University.

Professors with honorific titles include Adjunct Professors, Honorary Professors, Visiting Professors, Professors Emeritus, and any other category approved from time to time by the Vice Chancellor.

2. PROCEDURE

The Vice President (Corporate Services) is responsible for approving parking privileges for Professors with honorific titles.

In order for parking privileges to be granted, the relevant Deputy Vice Chancellor or Pro Vice Chancellor should make a case to the Vice President (Corporate Services) setting out the individual's association with the University and his/her need for access to parking.

Such parking privileges will be granted on a case-by-case basis.
