1. ROLE

The Dean (Research Infrastructure) plays a key role in the academic leadership of research infrastructure strategy, policy and operations.

The Dean (Research Infrastructure) reports to the Senior Deputy Vice Chancellor, and works closely with the Office for Research, the Group Deans (Research) and Centre Directors to facilitate and promote a strategic approach to research infrastructure development with the University, including the establishment of core research facilities; improve the effectiveness of utilisation and management of existing research infrastructure; and leverage research infrastructure to increase local, national and international research collaborations and access to funding opportunities.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and oversee implementation of University policy on core research infrastructure.
- Coordinate the development of Academic Group research infrastructure management plans in liaison with Deans Research and Research Institute and Centre Directors.
- Contribute to the review and evaluation of government policies on the development of national research infrastructure including NCRIS.
- Coordinate the submission of major infrastructure proposals, including ARC Linkage Infrastructure Equipment and Facilities (LIEF), both within the University and in collaboration with other research organisations.
- Chair the panel assessing Griffith University Research Infrastructure Program applications and make recommendation to the Senior Deputy Vice Chancellor on the allocation of research infrastructure funding.

3. REPORTING

The Dean (Research Infrastructure) reports directly to the Senior Deputy Vice Chancellor.
